Gate House Duties

Key Holding – The gatehouse offer a key holding facility, the concierges are able to hold keys and issue on your behalf (Maximum 48hrs) Before accepting a key you must complete a key holding disclaimer form, these are available from the gatehouse or the estates office, once completed the concierge will be able to hold keys for you.

Parcels – We are pleased to accept parcels on behalf of residents, before we can sign for a parcel or accept it on your behalf we do require you to complete a disclaimer form. These are available from the gatehouse or estates office and **must** be completed before we can accept a parcel on your behalf. Storage space within the gatehouse is tight, unfortunately we can only accept parcels that can be stored within the gatehouse, perishable items cannot be stored.

Resident Registration – In order to provide you with the best possible service we like to maintain accurate resident information, if you are new to the development or have recently changed your phone number or email address please contact the Estate office or Gatehouse for a residents registration form and once completed drop it back into either of them.

Electricity Readings – Our caretaker is able to take electricity readings for you. If you would like to take advantage of this service please call the estates office.

Security – In emergency cases always contact the police first, however please inform the gatehouse of any security concerns you may have.
